Get ready for the Fort Valley Ride! In less than a week, base camp will be filling with horses and riders. This is a wonderful ride in Fort Valley, Virginia during the peak season of leaf color! Come out and enjoy a challenging but doable ride in the mountains. We offer a 30- and 50-mile ride on both Friday October 22, 2021 and Saturday October 23, 2021, along with a variety of Ride & Tie distances both days. We also offer a 16-mile introductory mountain ride on Saturday. The ride goes up over a beautiful mountain and along the Shenandoah River with beautiful views of both and the valleys below. The trail is a mixture of technical rocky trail and forest service roads along with wide grassy stretches.





A group of dedicated people have been working diligently to clear the trails. In September, there was a large work group that mowed trails, cleared trees using chainsaws and other major trail clearing tools and opened it up for the ride.

In October, a smaller work group was finally able to open up Indian Graves. This opened up a section of trail that hasn't been used for years for this ride. This year the 50 milers get to try some new

PLEASE NOTE: ALL equine entries in all our rides—even the intro rides, without exception, are to be wearing four shoes, or an equivalent hoof protection (which include boots or glue-ons) at the start of the ride. The mountain trails on which our endurance competition takes place can be exceptionally difficult to strap-on boots, so we strongly suggest you might want to consider gluing any boots on.



Triple Crown

The Fort Valley is the culmination of the Triple Crown. The Triple Crown consists of completion of No Frills Ride in April held in Star Tannery, VA, the Old Dominion Ride in June held in Orkney Springs, VA and Fort Valley Ride in October in Fort Valley, VA. Each year the same horse and rider can ride any combination of distances offered at each ride (except for the introductory rides). If they successfully complete all three rides,




they are awarded the coveted Triple Crown! This year we have about 20 horse/rider teams eligible to complete the Triple Crown. We wish them all the best for an enjoyable ride and to finish with a happy, healthy, and sound horse. Last year, the award was a cute, embroidered pillow to celebrate the accomplishment.

His damline comes from the Russian greats *Moment and *Tamerlan crossed onto a granddaughter of the renowned U.S. Nat'l Ch. Synbad and has produced notables such as the Asgard herd stallion Syndicat and the much decorated endurance gelding Synthetic. Full siblings include Scinntilla, Scilhouette, and Scyfy.
